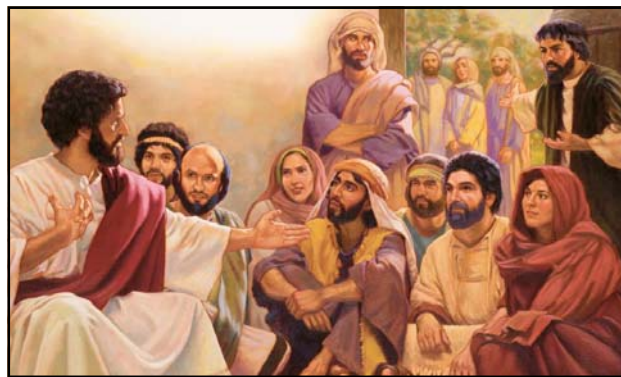

Tenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Sunday — June 10, 2018

The Gospel Reading is **Mark 3:20-35**

Jesus came home with his disciples. Again the crowd gathered, making it impossible for them even to eat. When his relatives heard of this they set out to seize him, for they said, "He is out of his mind." The scribes who had come from Jerusalem said, "He is possessed by Beelzebub," and "By the prince of demons he drives out demons." Summoning them, he began to speak to them in parables, "How can Satan drive out Satan? If a kingdom is divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand. And if a house is divided against itself, that house will not be able to stand. And if Satan has risen up against himself and is divided, he cannot stand; that is the end of him. But no one can enter a strong man's house to plunder his property unless he first ties up the strong man. Then he can plunder the house. Amen, I say to you, all sins and all blasphemies that people utter will be forgiven them. But whoever blasphemes against the Holy Spirit will never have forgiveness, but is guilty of an everlasting sin."



For they had said, "He has an unclean spirit." His mother and his brothers arrived. Standing outside they sent word to him and called him. A crowd seated around him told him, "Your mother and your brothers and your sisters are outside asking for you." But he said to them in reply, "Who are my mother and my brothers?" And looking around at those seated in the circle he said, "Here are my mother and my brothers. For whoever does the will of God is my brother and sister and mother."

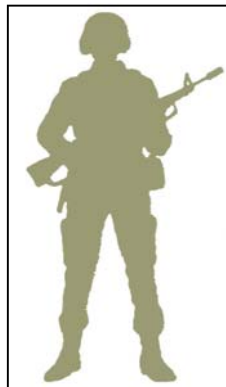

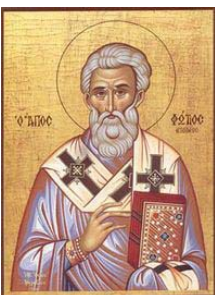
2018 Bishop's Annual Appeal

St. Getulius and Companions / Feastday: June 10th / **Death:** 120 AD

Martyr with Amantius, Caerealis, and Primitivus. He was the husband of St. Symphorosa. An officer in the Roman army, he resigned when he became a Christian and returned to his estates near Tivoli, Italy. There he converted Caerealis, an imperial legate sent to arrest him. Getulius was tortured and martyred at Tivoli, along with his brother Amantius and with Caerealis and Primitivus. He is a patron saint of vocations. Major Shrine: Sant'Angelo in Pescheria, Rome. Litany of the Sacred Heart of Jesus

June is dedicated to the Litany of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. (According to the USCCB - <http://www.usccb.org/prayer-and-worship/prayers-and-devotions/litanies/litany-of-the-sacred-heart-of-jesus.cfm>)

In 1899 Pope Leo XIII approved this Litany of the Sacred Heart of Jesus for public use. (Click on: https://www.ewtn.com/devotionals/litanies/sacred_heart.htm to view this version.)

This litany is actually a synthesis of several other litanies dating back to the 17th century. Father Croiset composed a litany in 1691 from which 17 invocations were used by Venerable Anne Madeleine Remuzat when she composed her litany in 1718 at Marseille. She joined an additional 10 invocations to those of Father Croiset, for a total of 27 invocations.

Six more invocations written by Sister Madeleine Joly of Dijon in 1686 were added by the Sacred Congregation for Rites when it was approved for public use in 1899.

This makes a total of 33 invocations, one for each year of life of our Lord Jesus Christ. A partial indulgence is attached to this litany.

Permanent Deacon Application & Training

The Office of the Permanent Diaconate is accepting applications for the next diaconate formation class. Applications accepted until September 30, 2018, with the actual classes starting in September of 2019. All application materials are available on the Savannah Diocese web site, under the link for the Permanent Diaconate office <http://diosav.org/permanent-diaconate-Formation>.

Applicants must be at least 35 years old at the time of Ordination, and can be no older than 60 years old at the time of formation (begins September 2019). Applicants must be practicing Catholics, should be active in their parish, and have a strong moral background. If married, they should have a stable family life and cannot have had more than one previous marriage, which must have been properly annulled by the Church. Moreover, they should meet with their pastors for discussion and discernment prior to sending in their applications. Additional information is available on the diocese web site at: diosav.org

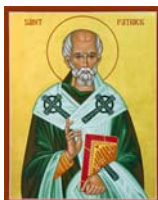

Proper Disposal of Sacramental Items

The Knights of Columbus will collect your worn out or broken sacramental items and dispose of them in a reverent manner, according to church teachings.



The collection jar is on the Knights of Columbus table in the Narthex. Rosaries will be inspected (then repaired and reused if possible).

Please do not leave family heirlooms in the jar.

St. Patrick Catholic Church Sacramental Policies

Baptism

- * Parents must be registered at St. Patrick and attend Mass for **3 months before** preparation.
- * Parents must attend Baptism Prep Class so, **call the office** to register for class!
- * Godparents are invited to attend.
- * At least one Godparent must be Catholic.
- * Out of town Godparents must provide a letter from their pastor as to their suitability to exercise this office.

Marriage – Couples must:

- * Contact the pastor **at least 6 months** (or more) **prior** to desired wedding date.
- * Complete FOCCUS inventory
- * Participate in a pre-Cana course or marriage-prep weekend.
- * **NO** wedding date is guaranteed until **ALL** Diocesan and Parish requirements are fulfilled.

First Communion and Confirmation

- * Family must be registered at St. Patrick.
- * Preparation = two years of classes.
- * Children must be at least **7 years old** to receive First Communion **and** at least **13 years old** for Confirmation.

We have **special hosts**, approved by the Vatican, with a very low wheat gluten content. Call the church office and let us know if you need this type of host.
