## Second Sunday of Lent

**Sunday — March 5, 2023**

**Gospel Reading: Matthew 17:1—9**

Jesus took Peter, James, and John his brother, and led them up a high mountain by themselves. And he was transfigured before them; his face shone like the sun and his clothes became white as light. And behold, Moses and Elijah appeared to them, conversing with him. Then Peter said to Jesus in reply, "Lord, it is good that we are here. While he was still speaking, behold, a bright cloud cast a shadow over them, then from the cloud came a voice that said, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him." ## St. Patrick Catholic Church Mission Statement

We are a Community of Word and Sacrament, Called by  
CHRIST to grow in Faith, Hope, and Love; Foster  
Community; and Evangelize.

**Fasting and Abstinence Rules:**

Ash Wednesday & Good Friday are mandatory days of **fasting** for Catholics within the age range of 18 through 59.

**Minimum requirements for fasting:**

One full meal is permitted. Two smaller meals are also permitted but these smaller meals should not add up to a full meal. Snacks between meals **are not** permitted.

Water, coffee, and tea may be consumed throughout the day. People may engage in stricter forms of fasting if they choose but, for appropriate health reasons, people may be excused from fasting.

**Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence.**

This means abstaining from eating meat. Seafood and eggs are permitted. This rule applies to Catholics age 14 and over.

To help defray the cost of **Altar flowers for Easter**, donation envelopes are in the Narthex.

You may donate 'In Memory of' **or** 'In Honor of' a loved one or friend. Print names on envelope.

Names will be listed in the Easter Sunday bulletin on April 9<sup>th</sup>, **and** the Divine Mercy Sunday bulletin on April 16<sup>th</sup>.

**Sacramental Policies**

**Baptism**

- \* Parents **must be registered** at St. Patrick and attend Mass for **3 months before** preparation.
- \* Parents must attend Baptism Prep Class so, please **call the office** to register for class!
- \* Godparents are invited to attend Baptism class.
- \* At least one godparent must be a Catholic good standing.
- \* **Non – St. Patrick godparents** must provide a sponsorship letter from their home parish office. The letter must be received by St. Patrick Church office **prior to** requesting a date for the Baptism.

**Marriage – Couples must:**

- \* Contact the pastor at least 6 months (or more) prior to desired wedding date.
- \* Complete FOCCUS inventory
- \* Participate in a pre-Cana course or marriage-prep weekend.
- \* **NO** wedding date is guaranteed until **ALL** Diocesan and parish requirements are fulfilled.

**First Communion and Confirmation**

- \* Family must be registered at St. Patrick.
- \* Preparation = two years of classes.
- \* Children must be at least **7 years old** to receive First Communion, **and** at least **14 years old** to receive Confirmation.

**The Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People**

is a comprehensive set of procedures established by the USCCB in June 2002 for addressing allegations of sexual abuse of minors by Catholic clergy.

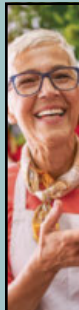

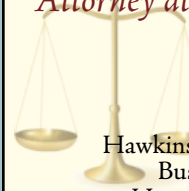

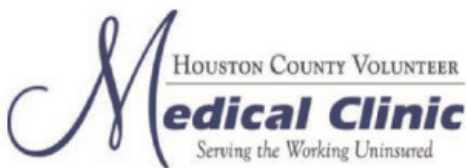
