On the first day of the week, Mary of Magdala came to the tomb early in the morning, while it was still dark, and saw the stone removed from the tomb. Then the other disciple also went in, the one who had arrived at the tomb first, and he saw and believed. For they did not yet understand the Scripture that he had to rise from the dead.

St. Patrick Catholic Church **Sacramental Policies**

Baptism

- Parents must be registered at St. Patrick and attend Mass for **3 months before** preparation.
- Parents must attend Baptism Prep Class so, please **call the office** to register for class!
- Godparents are invited to attend Baptism class.
- At least one godparent must be a Catholic good standing.
- Non St. Patrick godparents must provide a sponsorship letter from their home parish office. The letter must be received by St. Patrick Church office **prior to** requesting a date for the Baptism.

Marriage – Couples <u>must</u>:

- Contact the pastor at least 6 months (or more) prior to desired wedding date.
- Complete FOCCUS inventory
- Participate in a pre-Cana course or marriage-prep
- NO wedding date is guaranteed until ALL Diocesan and parish requirements are fulfilled.

First Communion and Confirmation

- Family must be registered at St. Patrick.
- Preparation = two years of classes.
- Children must be at least 7 years old to receive First Communion, and at least 14 years old to receive Confirmation.

The Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People

is a comprehensive set of procedures established by the USCCB in June 2002 for addressing allegations of sexual abuse of minors by Catholic clergy.


