## Our Little Free Library (LFL) is now set up!

## Here are some things to be aware of:

A LFL is intended to serve the whole community/neighborhood, not just, say, our parishioners. Although I was considering placing it near the labyrinth, I decided to relocate it in our driveway area. The reason is that it needs to be visible for vehicles on the highway and pedestrians on the sidewalk.

Our LFL is not handicap accessible at this time. This is not a requirement of the LFL organization, and many are not. We can look at making it handicap accessible in the future. For now, handicapped people can be assisted by those who are not.

A LFL is not meant to be a kind of drive thru service, so it is not located adjacent to the curb. People are expected to park in one of our parking spaces and walk to it. Some people will naturally park in our driveway in order to use it, and I do not see this as a problem unless an event is going on in the church. I suspect that no one would be so discourteous to do this when traffic is steadily going in and out of our parking lot (see as it would block those trying to exit).

In terms of safety, people can stand in front of our LFL and be about the same distance from our driveway as they would be if standing on a sidewalk. Keep in mind that the only time there is significant traffic in our driveway is just before an event (Mass, Religious Education classes, Knights of Columbus meetings, etc.) and when it lets out. Those concerned about vehicles driving in the area of the LFL can simply select a time to use it accordingly. For example, most Catholics arrive for Mass (or other event) within ten minutes of its starting time, and leave within ten minutes of it ending. Other than this, our driveway does not have a significant volume of traffic. Once we open up the second driveway, it will have even less.

Obviously, small children would not use our LFL without being accompanied by an adult or at least a larger kid because a small

kid could not reach the books. Because people can use our LFL at any time day or night, it is positioned underneath one of our street lights. Placing it any further from the curb would diminish the amount of light. The base of the LFL is filled with sand as is a portion of its stand. The wind is not going to knock it over unless it is a very powerful storm.

Our LFL is freestanding and the flagstone courtyard is actually made of removable stone mats laid upon the grass. Therefore, the entire setup is mobile. If someone has concerns about the location, they can address them to the Parish Council. If the concerns are deemed credible, then we will relocate the LFL.

## **Concerning the Use of our LFL:**

Although it is called a "library", a LFL does NOT involve signing out books, borrowing them for a while, and returning them. When visiting an LFL, one may take and keep any book they want (there is no limit). They are free to return books they don't want to keep to our LFL (or any other LFL). Moreover, they are free to donate books to a LFL by simply placing them in the box.

Our LFL is being registered with the LFL organization and will appear on the GPS of the LFL app. I am the official steward of our LFL. I will inspect it on a regular basis, and remove any inappropriate material.

If someone has a large quantity of books to donate (i.e., too many to put in the box), they can drop them off in the church and I will store them. I will periodically replenish our LFL from this book stash, or take them to other LFL locations.

FWIW, there are only two other LFLs in the Kathleen area, both of which are deep within neighborhoods. Our LFL is the most visible and accessible to the general public. Other than this, there are two LFLs in Perry (one near the hospital and one at the old courthouse). There are nine spread out in Warner Robins and Centerville, and one on base. ### St. Patrick Catholic Church Sacramental Policies

#### **Baptism**

- \* Parents <u>must be registered</u> at St. Patrick and attend Mass for **3 months before** preparation.
- \* Parents must attend Baptism Prep Class so, please **call the office** to register for class!
- \* Godparents are invited to attend Baptism class.
- \* At least <u>one</u> godparent must be a Catholic good standing.
- \* Non St. Patrick godparents must provide a sponsorship letter from their home parish office. The letter must be received by St. Patrick Church office **prior to** requesting a date for the Baptism.

#### Marriage – Couples <u>must</u>:

- \* Contact the pastor <u>at least</u> **6 months** (or more) <u>prior</u> to desired wedding date.
- \* Complete FOCCUS inventory
- \* Participate in a pre-Cana course or marriage-prep weekend.
- \* <u>NO</u> wedding date is guaranteed until <u>ALL</u> Diocesan and parish requirements are fulfilled.

#### **First Communion and Confirmation**

- \* Family must be registered at St. Patrick.
- \* Preparation = two years of classes.
- \* Children must be at least **7 years old** to receive First Communion, **and** at least **14 years old** to receive Confirmation.




