

### 2023 Annual Catholic Appeal

The purpose of the Annual Catholic Appeal (ACA) is to help raise funds and carry out the mission of our Dioceses. ACA envelopes and information booklets are in our Narthex.

The Diocese has committed 5% of the monies raised by the ACA to be considered a diocesan tithe. In keeping with his commitment to Stewardship, the Bishop has designated that these funds be used outside of our immediate needs for the good of the larger church and its people.

in the memo line. Put the check in the Office Box that sits outside the Church Office door. The Knights will make sure the school gets the money.

### They really need:

**School supplies** — (especially) see-through book bags that are at least 9" x 14" (to hold laptop computers), Wide ruled notebook paper, glue sticks, ball point pens, Mead composition books, sharpened pencils, pencil boxes, tissues, Markers (especially Flair pens) in all colors (for teachers), post-it notes of all sizes, and dry erase markers

<u>Personal products</u> — travel size deodorant, toothpaste, tooth brushes, dental floss, girls' hair clips, and ponytail holders

#### St. Patrick Catholic Church Sacramental Policies

#### **Baptism**

- Parents <u>must be registered</u> at St. Patrick and attend Mass for 3 months <u>before</u> preparation.
- \* Parents must attend Baptism Prep Class so, please **call the office** to register for class!
- \* Godparents are invited to attend Baptism class.
- \* At least <u>one</u> godparent must be a Catholic good standing.
- \* Non St. Patrick godparents must provide a sponsorship letter from their home parish office. The letter must be received by St. Patrick Church office **prior to** requesting a date for the Baptism.

#### Marriage - Couples must:

- Contact the pastor <u>at least</u> 6 months (or more) <u>prior</u> to desired wedding date.
- \* Complete FOCCUS inventory
- Participate in a pre-Cana course or marriage-prep weekend.
- \* NO wedding date is guaranteed until ALL Diocesan and parish requirements are fulfilled.

#### **First Communion and Confirmation**

- \* Family must be registered at St. Patrick.
- \* Preparation = two years of classes.
- Children must be at least 7 years old to receive First Communion, and at least
   14 years old to receive Confirmation.






