#### Thirty-third Sunday in Ordinary Time Sunday — November 19, 2023 Gospel Reading:

Jesus told his disciples this parable: "A man going on a journey called in his servants and entrusted his possessions to them. To one he gave five talents; to another, two; to a third, one -- to each according to his ability. Then he went away. Immediately the one who received five talents went and traded with them, and made another five. Likewise, the one who received two made another two. #### St. Patrick Catholic Church Sacramental Policies

#### **Baptism**

- Parents <u>must be registered</u> at St. Patrick and attend Mass for <u>3 months before</u> preparation.
- \* Parents must attend Baptism Prep Class so, please call the office to register for class!
- \* Godparents invited to attend Baptism class.
- \* At least <u>one</u> godparent must be a Catholic good standing.
- \* Non St. Patrick godparents must provide a sponsorship letter from their home parish office. The letter must be received by St. Patrick Church office prior to requesting a date for the Baptism.

#### **Marriage** – Couples must:

- \* Contact the pastor <u>at least</u> **6 months** (or more) <u>prior</u> to desired wedding date.
- \* Complete FOCCUS inventory
- Participate in a pre-Cana course or marriage-prep weekend.
- \* **NO** wedding date is guaranteed until **ALL** Diocesan and parish requirements are fulfilled.

#### **First Communion and Confirmation**

- \* Family must be registered at St. Patrick.
- \* Preparation = two years of classes.
- \* Children must be at least **7 years old** to receive First Communion, <u>and</u> at least **14 years old** to receive Confirmation.




