Gospel Reading: Mark 6:1–6

Jesus said to them, “A prophet is not without honor except in his native place and among his own kin and in his own house.” So he was not able to perform any mighty deed there, apart from curing a few sick people by laying his hands on them. He was amazed at their lack of faith.

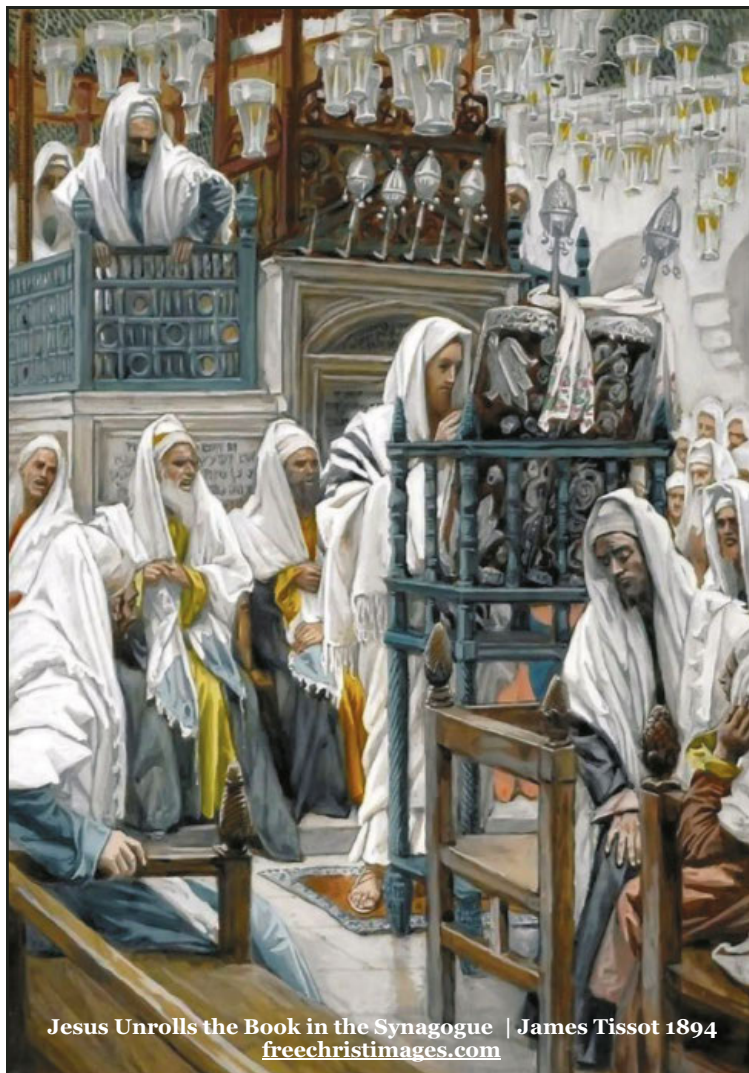

### St. Patrick Catholic Church Sacramental Policies

#### Baptism

- \* Parents **must be registered** at St. Patrick and attend Mass for **3 months before** preparation.
- \* Parents must attend Baptism Prep Class so, please **call the office to register for class!**
- \* Godparents invited to attend Baptism class.
- \* At least one godparent must be a Catholic good standing.
- \* **Non – St. Patrick godparents** must provide a sponsorship letter from their home parish office. The letter must be received by St. Patrick Church office **prior to** requesting a date for the Baptism.

#### Marriage – Couples must:

- \* Contact the pastor at least 6 months (or more) prior to desired wedding date.
- \* Complete FOCCUS inventory
- \* Participate in a pre-Cana course or marriage-prep weekend.
- \* **NO** wedding date is guaranteed until **ALL** Diocesan and parish requirements are fulfilled.

#### First Communion and Confirmation

- \* Family must be registered at St. Patrick.
- \* Preparation = two years of classes.
- \* Children must be at least **7 years old** to receive First Communion, **and** at least **14 years old** to receive Confirmation.

**The Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People** is a comprehensive set of procedures established in June 2002 by the USCCB for addressing allegations of sexual abuse of minors by Catholic clergy.

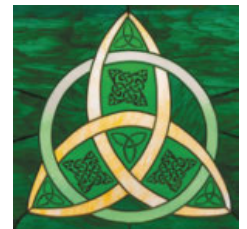

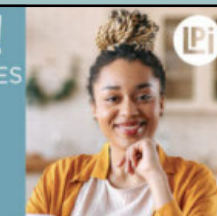

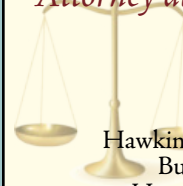
